STUDY PROCEDURE

- 1. Read and study, "35mm Disassembly Techniques."
- 2. You should know:
 - A. why you should remove the bottom cover first
 - B. how to use and how to soften locking agents
 - C. the general techniques and precautions in removing the top cover
 - D. how to adjust the transport latch
 - E. precautions in removing and replacing leatherette
 - F. how to check the flange-focal distance
 - G. techniques and precautions in removing and replacing front standards.
